



Lesson: MAKE SOME CHRISTMAS BON BONS

In this lesson, we will create some Christmas Bon Bons. You can decorate your Bon Bons with paint, coloured paper, wrapping paper, stickers, stamps, ribbon, string, tape or any other art and craft supplies you may have. Bon Bons are often placed on the table during Christmas lunch or dinner. So, let's gather our supplies and start creating!

Step 1	Gather your supplies. You can choose to use paint, coloured paper, wrapping paper, stickers, stamps, ribbon, craft tape or any other items you may have, for this activity. To create our Bon Bons, we will use paper towel roll, brown paper and ribbons.	
Step 2	Start by carefully cutting your paper towel roll to approximately 12-15cm. (Alternatively, you can make your own cardboard rolls by rolling up a piece of cardboard and adding a bit of glue or tape).	
Step 3	Lay some paper (you can use wrapping paper) on a clean table and place the roll centred at one end. Carefully wrap the paper over the paper towel roll and join with some sticky tape or a bit of glue.	



<p>Step 4</p>	<p>Cut two pieces of ribbon of equal lengths approximately 25-30cm long. Carefully gather the ends together. Tie some ribbon around one end. Tie a bow, like you are tying your shoelaces.</p> <p>Before you tie ribbon around the other end, you might like to add a couple of wrapped lollies and/or a joke inside the Bon Bon. Once you've added the goodies, you can then tie a bow at this end of the Bon Bon.</p>	
<p>Step 5</p>	<p>Complete your Bon Bon with decorations that you would like to use – such as some Christmas wrapping paper, stamps, stickers, or some paint. They are then ready to be placed on the table for Christmas! (Please note: this Bon Bon design is not a 'pull-apart' design. These Bon Bons can be opened by your family and guests by untying the ribbons).</p>
